

FAQ - Frequently asked questions

Thank you for your interest in the Swiss Ski School Kleine Scheidegg. Our ski school offers professional class and private lessons with many local ski instructors who know the area:

GROUP LESSONS FOR CHILDREN

Duration of lessons

- Depending on the level of the child, the group lessons are 2 or 3 hours in the morning from Monday to Friday | 3 hours are mostly for the slightly older children who are already confident in snowploughing on blue slopes 'Level Blue King'
 - Of course, younger children who get tired after 2 hours also have the option of attending the lessons for 'only' 2 hours

Class sizes

- Class sizes are from 3 to max. 8 children
- For our youngest guests, Kids Village & Blue Princes, the group size is from 3 to max. 6 children

* On individual days in the high season, it is possible that we may exceed the group sizes at short notice

Break during lessons

- When teaching our youngest guests, Level Swiss Snow Kids Village & Blue Prince, a break with tea/water and snacks is included
- No break is planned for the Blue King level and above. However, depending on the situation, a break will be taken. On Kleine Scheidegg, the routes to the ski school office are short and can be catered for with tea/water and small snacks if necessary

Start & end of group lessons:

- SKI | Start of the lesson on the Kleine Scheidegg. 09.20 in front of the sports shop Wyss Sport
 - SNOWBOARD | Start 12.55 | End 15.00 on Kleine Scheidegg
 - SKI | End of lessons on Kleine Scheidegg | 11.30 for Swiss Snow Kids Village & Blue Prince levels | 12.30 for class lessons from Blue King level upwards
- ➔ The children's carers take the children to Kleine Scheidegg, where they are also picked up again after the lesson. The ski school does not offer a pick-up service in Grindelwald or Wengen

Ski race

- Always take place on Thursday. The ranking ceremony is on Thursday after the lessons (11.30am and 12.30pm). Each child receives a medal

PRIVATE LESSONS

Offer:

- In high season only 3 hours or full day bookable
 - Morning lessons start at 08.30 / 09.00 / 09.30 || in the afternoon from 13.00
- Start & end of lessons mostly on Kleine Scheidegg in front of the sports shop "Wyss Sport"
 - Other start & end times of lessons may be possible on request
- On request, we are also happy to ski in the Grindelwald First / Männlichen or Schilthorn ski areas

Start / end of private lessons

- Private lessons meeting: depending on the start time, 10 minutes before the lesson at Wyss Sport in front of the sports shop on Kleine Scheidegg
- Private lessons full day 5 or 6 hours. Meeting points by arrangement with the ski school at the hotel in Grindelwald, Wengen Lauterbrunnen. If 6 hours of lessons are booked, a meeting in Interlaken is also possible.

HOW TO GET TO KLEINE SCHEIDEGG

Public transport | which we highly recommend

- Trains from Interlaken OST via Lauterbrunnen or Grindelwald | every 30 min: [check timetable SBB](#)
 - Eiger Express from Grindelwald Terminal
 - **Park & Ride Matten**
- **Guest level beginners, as well as those who have not skied for a long time; here we recommend travelling to Kleine Scheidegg by train from Interlaken Ost / Matten Park & Ride / Wilderswil / Lauterbrunnen / Wengen or Grindelwald / Grindelwald Grund**
- Via Eiger Express: a blue slope leads from the Eigergletscher directly to Kleine Scheidegg. For guests who are already 'confident' on the slopes, then it is a good alternative of using the train
- **It is not possible** to drive up to Kleine Scheidegg by car. Those arriving by car must park their car. We recommend using the Park & Ride car park in Matten.

PARKING | PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- We generally recommend travelling by public transport, as the roads to Grindelwald or Lauterbrunnen are generally very busy

GENERAL INFORMATION about the 'KLEINE SCHEIDEGG'

- The beginner's area is located directly below the Kleine Scheidegg at around 2000 metres above sea level
- Kleine Scheidegg is in the centre of [the Jungfrau Region ski area](#) with many different slopes and chairlifts
- Winter hiking trails lead from Kleine Scheidegg in both directions to Grindelwald & Wengen
- Kleine Scheidegg can be reached every 30 minutes by train from Wengen or Grindelwald
- Kleine Scheidegg can be reached with the Eiger Express cable car, a blue slope leads from the Eigergletscher mountain station down to Kleine Scheidegg.
- Several restaurants are located near the ski school office
- It is possible to spend the night on the Kleine Scheidegg

- A small locker can be rented from Wyss Sport for your personal equipment
